Buy a Board Campaign - \$25/BOARD: For each board you will receive a charitable tax receipt, a certificate suitable for framing & a small plaque mounted on an interior wall in the pavilion under a heading indicating that these people are Friends of Chippewa Park and contributed to its reconstruction.

Buy a Tree or Bench: It started with Trees Thunder Bay and continues today. For \$450 you can have a large caliper tree planted at Chippewa Park as part of our landscaping plan. To-date we have had over 100 trees planted through the combined efforts of a number of organizations and volunteers. You can also order a commemorative bench for \$1400 (and that includes a plaque). A number are already located throughout the park. Funds go to the City of Thunder Bay to pay for the tree or bench and its ongoing maintenance. Call the parks department at 625-2313 for details.
